Vaccinations are only undertaken following a full consultation with the pharmacist, including details of travel plans, locations to be visited within countries and your medical history. Before departure, all travellers should ensure that they are up to date with the routine NHS (or equivalent) childhood vaccinations. Children aged up to 15 years must have a parent/guardian present and able to complete the consultation on their behalf. Prices are subject to change. Stocks of particular vaccines may not always be available.
