

Using OpenDNS to Block Adult Sites

There are loads of tools out there to block adult sites - here's how to secure your entire home network for free in under two minutes using OpenDNS.

1. Put your router's IP address (usually 192.168.1.1) in the address bar of your internet browser.



2. Log in with your admin account and password. This is usually different to your WiFi password.

3. Look for your DNS settings and take note of them in case you ever need to revert back.

4. Change the DNS settings to the OpenDNS IP addresses, 208.67.222.123 & 208.67.220.123.

Primary DNS	<input type="text" value="208.67.222.123"/>
Secondary DNS	<input type="text" value="208.67.220.123"/>
