Complex care is sometimes referred to as long-term live-in care or continuing complex care. This type of care is rather more complicated it should only be administered by trained carers who are proficient in an array of specific caring methods.


Home care or care home?

The majority of people believe they will have to move into a nursing home if they require 24/7 care and support. However, it is widely recognised in the medical profession that receiving nurse-led care at home can have far reaching benefits to someone needing complex care.

Our professional carers are highly trained to provide nurse-led delegated tasks usually undertaken by a district nurse. This means you can stay in the comfort and familiarity of your own home with all the medical and holistic support you need, and all on a one-to-one basis – something even the very best nursing home cannot provide.

Our home care service is comparable to that of a care home. The difference is that you or a loved one does not have to eat from a limited menu or wait until an upset resident calms down. We don't want anyone to experience this kind of institutionalisation, and we therefore ensure that our Carers stimulate you or a loved one throughout the day and make sure all is well at night. We strongly urge you to consider live-in care before organising residential placements even on a trial basis. If live-in care is not right for you, it is easy to make the transition to a residential facility.

Unfortunately, if you are placed in residential care and find that you are unhappy there, it is harder to move back into your own home and your independence moves further and further away.



Who we work with

Private customers

We work closely with individuals, families and healthcare professionals to develop a unique, person-centred complex care plan which identifies all their requirements. This allows them to have choice and control over their care enabling them to lead independent, active and fulfilled lives.

Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs)

We work closely alongside CCGs and local authorities to provide quality-focused and patient-centred care services for people with complex care needs who are also eligible for the NHS continuing healthcare funding with CCG-agreed care at home packages. NHS continuing healthcare funding (CHC) is a package of continuing care funded by the NHS, for those who require complex or palliative care.

Personal Health Budgets (PHB)

We also work with people who have personal health budgets (PHBs). PHBs is money provided by the NHS to support specific healthcare needs to set up a care package with a home care agency of their choice.

Case Managers and Solicitors

We work closely with case managers and personal injury solicitors to provide bespoke individual person centred care packages for people who have complex care needs.

We provide:

Case study

From a young age, Graham has always been into motorbikes, however his life changed dramatically on the way back home from a holiday when he was involved in a traffic accident. Martin suffered a spinal cord injury and his world was turned upside down. After rehabilitation at Stoke Mandeville, spinal Injury centre he was ready to return home.

However Graham had complex needs and required high levels of personal care and rehabilitation. The accident changed Graham's perspective - he didn't want to rely heavily on his family for 24/7 care and support - he was only 33 and wanted to continue to live his life independently at home.

A health care professional advised they use a live-in care agency who can support a wide range of complex care needs. Independent People Homecare came highly recommended as they provide a nurse-led, tailored approach to make sure individuals can remain living in the comfort of their own home. After the initial care assessment with their clinical care team, Graham was adamant he wanted a male carer and someone who shared his passion for motorbikes. Why choose complex care at home?

Live-in care is very different to the care provided in residential care homes. In care homes, staff work in shift patterns – this meaning there is no consistency when it comes to who is providing care. Some people can find the fact they have little control over the events that happen around them disorientating. In care homes it is easy to become institutionalised, unstimulated and lose all independence completely.

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Nursing care expertise

Our in-house, specialist clinical nurse team has a wealth of nursing expertise and experience. They are there to provide medical assessments, clinical insights and home visits to those receiving care at home. They also work closely with health care professionals, continuing health care teams (CHC) and clinical commissioning groups (CCG) to arrange fast-track home care packages as well as providing emotional support to their families at what can be a difficult time.

Additionally, our clinical nurse team provides hands-on support and advice to our regional care teams to ensure nurse-led training, guidance and best practises for our staff. This enables us to provide the highest level of complex care for customers to live independently at home.

> Step 1: Call to arrange a FREE live-in care assessment

All care assessments are free of charge. When you call the office we will discuss appropriate times and dates for a care manager and a member of our clinical care nurse team to meet you and the person requiring live-in care either at home, hospital or even a care home.

Step 2 − The live-in care assessment

At this meeting we will assess the person needing care discussing their individual needs and requirements. We'll talk you through the service, answering any questions you may have and a discuss the type of live-in carer you are looking for – we not only match their care needs, but we also try to match their hobbies and interests too.

At this meeting we can they provide you with a definitive weekly cost.

Step 3 − We create a complex care and support plan

We will then put together a care and support plan which could even include recommendations for home adaptations or appropriate equipment. Once a care plan is agreed, we'll assemble a specialist team, trained to meet your requirements. Each care package is led and coordinated by a registered nurse and a clinically-trained care associate.

Step 4 − Choose the right live-in carer

We'll help you find a live-in carer. We'll source a selection of live-in carers which we feel most accurately suit your requirements.

Step 5 − Choose a suitable starting date

Once you are happy with your choice of carer we will then arrange a suitable starting date. On your chosen start date – a member of our clinical nurse team will accompany the live-in carer to the customer's home.
