

Mock CEM 11 Plus Tests

Beaconsfield School of English is a leading provider of Mock CEM 11 Plus Test sessions in South Buckinghamshire. These take place in Beaconsfield and are administered on various Saturdays between February and August.

The Mock Test results provide children and parents with an independent, external assessment of their progress towards their 11 Pus goal.

Children from around Buckinghamshire, Berkshire and the Greater London area sit the tests, gaining valuable experience of formal test conditions.

The Mock CEM 11 Plus Tests are suitable for children who will be taking the Bucks or Berks versions of the CEM 11 Plus. Children sit two Mock Tests per Test Session, with CEM-style 11 Plus questions and question formats.

Parents can book one or a combination of Test Sessions. The School offers children the opportunity to take up to six CEM (Durham) style mock tests.

English for Au Pairs

South Buckinghamshire is a popular destination for au pairs and Beaconsfield School of English provides a part-time English for Au Pairs living in the area course to help them improve their English during their time in England.

The course is suitable for au pairs who already have a good level of general English. The teaching focuses on the four main skills - speaking, listening, reading and writing - and on developing knowledge of general vocabulary, useful everyday phrases, informal English, idioms and colloquial English. The course also covers aspects of British culture and topics of current interest.

Many au pairs decide to take an English examination during their stay. If you are planning to take an English examination such as IELTS, Cambridge First or Cambridge Advanced, we can also help you prepare for the exam during your English for Au Pairs course.

The minimum age to register on the English for Au Pairs course is 18. The lessons take place in a convenient central location in Beaconsfield Old Town, close to local bus routes and with free parking very close by.

The lessons are on two mornings per week, on Wednesdays and Fridays from 10am-11.30am. The well-appointed classrooms are warm, comfortable and quiet and in a modern building.

One to One English

We teach **General English** levels from Beginner to Advanced, and your course book and other materials will be selected by your teacher according to your level.

The levels we teach are based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). This Framework has 3 broad categories — Basic User, Independent Speaker and Proficient Speaker — and six levels, from A1 to C2.

On successful completion of your One to One English course you will receive an End of Course Certificate indicating your current level of English and recommendations for further study.

Location



Beaconsfield is a historical market town near London and Heathrow Airport. It is easily accessible by car and train — Heathrow Airport is around 20 minutes by car via the M40 motorway, and Marylebone Train Station in Central London is just over 20 minutes by train.

Beaconsfield has two parts – the **Old Town** with its ancient church and traditional pubs, and the **New**

Town, where the train station, shops, cafes and fashion stores are all located.

Beaconsfield lies within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, a protected area with magnificent woodlands and rolling hills.

The town is in the London "commuter belt" with very regular trains to London Marylebone mainline train station. **Wembley Stadi**um and **Wembley Arena** are just minutes away, along the same Chiltern Railways route.
