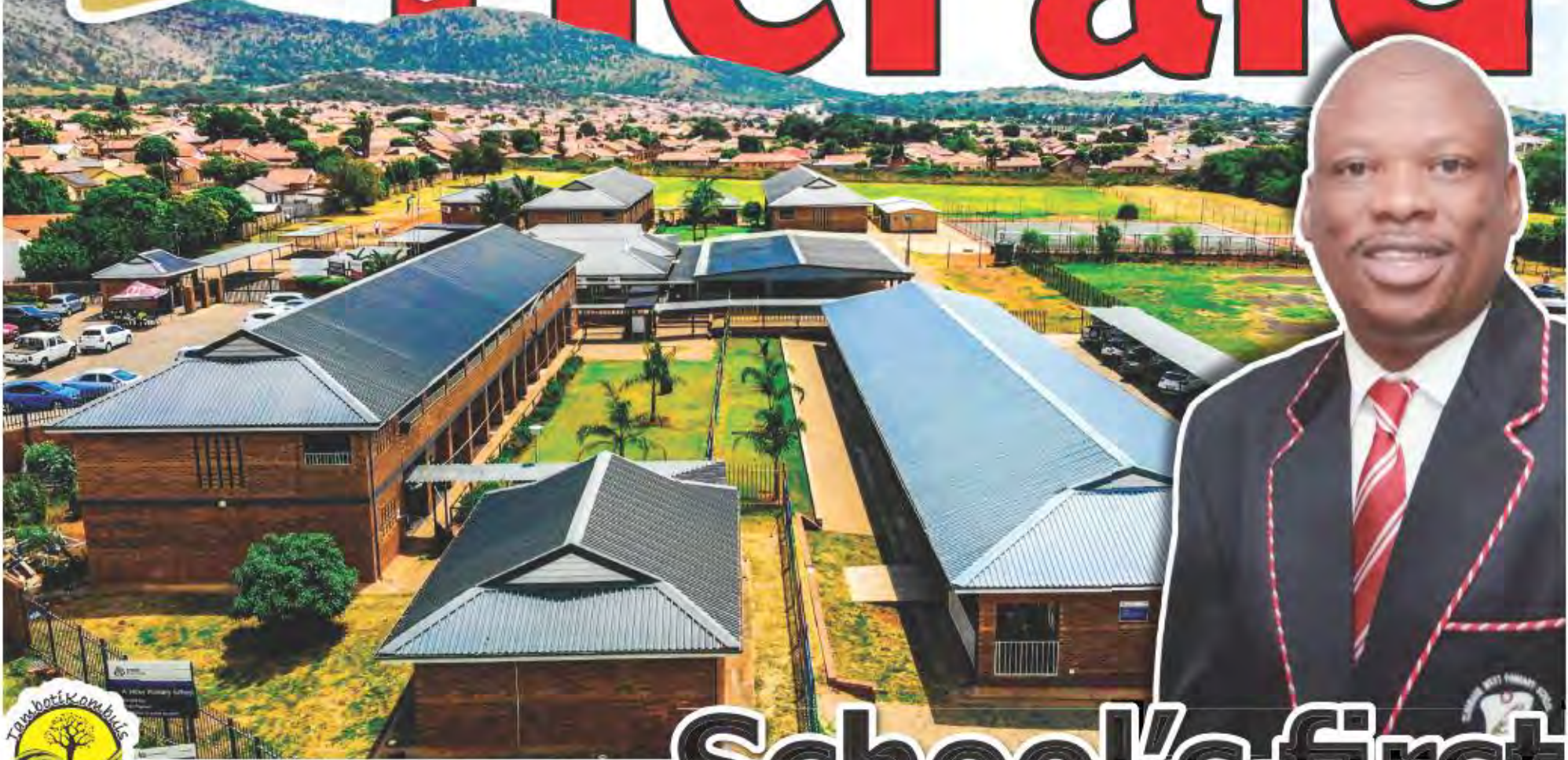


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# Rustenburg Herald

The daughter is holding a sunflower, which is magical in its ability to move its head toward the sun, resonant of the resilience, optimism and hopefulness of the young," said the agency.

# Twêe vas vir besit van renosterhoring

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - BENONI** - Twêe middeljarige mans is voorverlede Maandag in Benoni weens die onwettige besit van renosterhoring deur die polisie in hegtenis geneem.

Albei mans is blykbaar inwoners van Pretoria. Die twee mans - Timon Bodenstein, voorheen van Rustenburg, en Bartosz Rachwalski is onderskeidelik 39 en 38 jaar oud. Rachwalski is 'n Poolse burger en is voorheen romanties verbind met die sosiale vlinder - Loui Fish, 'n eens gewilde model. Die mans het in 'n luukse motor gereis toe hulle deur die polisie voorgekeer is en die motor deursoek is. Bodenstein en Rachwalski was volgens die polisie in besit van 'n "taamlike" groot renosterhoring wat in die motor se bagasiebak in plastieksakke versteek is. Daar is op die voertuig beslag gelê en die saak is sedertdien aan die Valke oorhandig. Volgens 'n woordvoerder van die polisie het ondersoekbeampies toegeslaan nadat hulle op 'n wenk gereageer het dat daar 'n transaksie met renosterhoring in Benoni sou plaasvind. Die ondersoek duur intussen voort, het 'n woordvoerder van die Valke gesê.

# One arrested for possession of illegal firearm and ammunition

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - REUTLWILE** - A 35-year-old man has been arrested for illegal possession of firearm and ammunition by the Rustenburg Flying Squad on Tuesday afternoon (16 March) at Reutlwile Informal Settlement near Zinniville.

According to information received from Rustenburg police spokesperson, Sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, while members of the Flying Squad were on patrol in the area, they noticed a suspicious black BMW with no registration number on the front. The vehicle initially had five occupants. The police followed the vehicle and stopped it, four of the occupants unfortunately got away while one was arrested. A search was conducted and two pistols, with ammunition were recovered. The suspect was arrested and charged with illegal possession of firearm and ammunition, he is expected to appear in the Rustenburg Magistrates Court this week.

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# Forget about hot cross buns, fuel is taking all your money

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG** - This year observing Lent will be much easier.

You will have a lot less money to spent on food or anything festive seeing that the petrol price is predicted to go up by almost R1 per litre.

Early indications, based on mid-month data from the Central Energy Fund (CEF), show that motorists are expected to take yet another hefty knock at the fuel pumps in April.

Following significant increase in the prices of petrol, diesel and illuminating paraffin since the beginning of 2021, consumers may have to brace themselves for an increase of up to 90c per litre for petrol and 66c for the equivalent amount of diesel.

This is according to BusinessTech, which on Monday 15 March 2021 reported that the latest CEF data points an "under-recovery across the board" — which is likely then to translate a sharp price increase at the pumps.

WHAT IS THE EXPECTED FUEL PRICE INCREASES FOR APRIL?

### Based on inland pricing:

- Petrol 95: increase of 90 cents per litre;
- Petrol 93: increase of 87 cents per litre;
- Diesel 0.05%: increase of 66 cents per litre;
- Diesel 0.005%: increase of 65 cents per litre;
- Illuminating paraffin: increase of 62 cents per litre.

### This is how the expected prices would reflect:

### FUEL PRICE TAXES

April will also see tax changes around the fuel price come into effect. In National Treasury's 2021 budget, it was announced that motorists will pay an inflation-related increase of 15 cents/litre in the general fuel levy and a higher-than-inflation increase of 11 cents/litre in the Road Accident Fund levy. This will add a combined 26 cents per litre to fuel prices from April, which would push increases to more than R1.00 per litre for petrol.

## Service delivery issues: Memorandum to RLM Mayor

### RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG

The level of service delivery has slumped to a disgracefully low level. Basic services, such as water and electricity provision are basically non-existent in most parts of Rustenburg. Crime is increasing rapidly, and most people see no future in Rustenburg due to lack of job opportunities.

The areas that are greatly affected by interruptions to power supply mainly include: Waterkloof, Rhenosterfontein, Zuurplaat, Arnoldstad, Kroondal, Waterval, Modderfontein, Boschfontein, Oorsaak, Thlabane, Boitekong as well as the northern regions.

The residents of the aforementioned areas have been suffering constant electrical blackouts for several months.

Many of these residents reside on smallholdings and their only source of water is the boreholes on their properties. The electrical interruptions limit their access to clean water, because the pumps cannot

function during the affected times. The interruptions damage electrical appliances and pose a major safety threat as electrical fencing also does not work during these periods. Furthermore, the following issues are also a disgrace throughout the entire RLM:

- Potable water provision
- Waste collection services.
- Condition of roads.
- Safety and drugs.
- Streetlights.
- Sewerage infrastructure.
- Maintenance of parks and public spaces.
- Set up meeting to view all contracts pertaining to service delivery within and around Rustenburg

Therefore, we as members of the community, demand the following:

1. Action plan for improved electricity provision within 48 hours.
2. The striking of municipal workers is resolved within 48 hours.
3. Sustainable electricity provision is restored

to the affected areas within seven days.

4. Qualified workers are appointed in the electrical and water departments.

5. The community is consulted in the monitoring of work done to electrical infrastructure and water infrastructure.

6. Sustainable water provision is restored within 24 hours.

7. RLM must provide us with an economic blue print on how they plan to grow and support local businesses within two months.

8. RLM must provide us with a strategic plan on how they intend to maintain and create jobs within two months.

9. RLM must provide a detailed plan on how they plan to eradicate poverty within two months.

10. RLM must provide us with a plan to protect the rights of women and for women empowerment within two months.

11. RLM must provide us with a strategic plan on how they will improve service delivery within two months.



## Rustenburg residents march for service delivery

Skade van meer as R400 000 is die afgelope Saterdagoggend kort na 01:00 by 'n bekende hondsalon net buite Kroondal aangerig toe die hoofgebou waarin die "Doggy Parlour" geleë was, deur 'n brand verwoes is.

Me Christelle Pretorius - die afgelope vier jaar reeds die eienares van "Sharlom Yorkie-tique en Doggy Spa" sê sy is verbysterd deur die voorval en het derduisende rande se skade gely. Toerusting soos elektroniese toerusting, knippers, handdoeke, was- en kammiddels, sjampoos, hondehokkies en so meer is deur die brand verwoes.

Geskikte diereliefhebbers en kliënte wat navraag gedoen het, wou dadelik weet of daar nie van die salon se honde-kliënte was wat in die voorval beseer is nie, maar "nee, ons hou gelukkig nie ons hondjies oornag nie en almal kom slegs vir 'n dag se knip en was en gaan dan weer huis toe", het Pretorius gesê. Gelukkig is die salon se dienste darem ook nie heeltemal tot 'n einde nie aangesien enkele van die salon se toerusting nie in die gebou was toe die brand uitbreek het nie. Enkele knippers, handdoeke, komberse en soortgelyke artikels wat op ander plekke gestoor was, sal intussen handig te pas kom om die salon se dienste voort te sit. Pretorius het aan die Herald bevestig dat 'n voorval van brandstigting deur die polisie ondersoek word. "Kliënte word met vrymoedigheid genooi om steeds hulle diere na ons te bring waar hulle slegs die beste sorg en baie liefde sal ontvang. # Getraumatiseerde vrou vertel van nagmerrie-aanval in plaashuis

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - DERBY** - 'n Gesin van die plaas Elandsfontein by Derby is nou nog erg getraumatiseer en in skok en word snags wakker van nagmerries nadat die gesin onlangs in die middel van die week ('n Donderdagoggend) omstreeks 03:00 deur drie gewapende aanvallers in hul huis oorval is.

Die egpaar - Maarten (51) en Alicia (41) van Wyk asook hulle twee dogters Ané (11) en Lianke (13) is verras terwyl hulle in die bed was en is vir 'n tydperk wat soos 'n ewigheid gevoel het, herhaaldelik met 'n ysterpyp deur die gesin, heup en op die rug geslaan terwyl hulle dogters kwaai rondgeruk en met die plathand geklap is. Die egpaar het wakker geword toe die aanvallers waarvan sommige maskers gedra het met 'n flitslig in hul oë geskyn en geskree het dat hulle moet wakker word. Die een man het deurentyd 'n ysterpyp in sy hand gehad terwyl die ander met 'n rewolwer en langgeweer gewapen was. Die gesin vermoed dat die aanvallers voor die aanval een of ander middel in en om die huis gespyt het omdat almal buitengewoon vas geslaap het. Die oudste dogter het bowendien vroeër die dag sterk medikasie gebruik nadat sy siek van die skool af by die huis aangekom het. Die aanvallers het deurentyd geskree dat hulle weet daar is geld in die huis en dat hulle wil weet waar dit was en dat hulle een van die gesinslede sou doodmaak indien hulle nie die geld vind nie. Hulle wou ook weet waar die sleutel van die kluis was wat in die kamer gestaan het maar deur die geharwar van die aanval en trauma, kon mev Alicia van Wyk dit nie vind nie omdat sy nie goed sonder haar kontaklenke kan sien nie wat in daardie stadium nog in die badkassie gelê het. Die mans het ook gedreig dat hulle Alicia sou verkrag indien hulle nie die inligting kry waarna hulle soek nie, en het in 'n stadium ook gedreig om een van die dogters te verkrag. Dit het die aanvallers buitengewoon lank geneem om agter te kom dat daar 'n

tweede dogter (die oudste) in 'n bo-kamer in die huis geslaap het omdat sy weens die medikasie baie vas geslaap het.

Sy is nietemin later gevind en na die egpaar se slaapkamer gedwing waar die gesin vir lang tyd aangehou is, gedreig, geslaan en getraumatiseer is. Alicia is in 'n stadium na

buite gedwing sodat van die voertuie op die erf ook oopgesluit en deursoek kon word. Hy is op pad na die voertuie deur die gesin se Jack Russel aan die been beetgekry maar hy die hond met die ysterpyp oor die kop geslaan en die hond het tjankend weggehardloop en gaan weggelooi.

Van die gesinslede het telkens probeer om ongesiens op hul selfone hulp te ontbied maar is kort-kort betrap, waarna die fone afgeneem is. Dit blyk dat een van die dogters

later suksesvol was om 'n noodsein na 'n buurplaas en buurtwag gestuur te kry (wat sy net drie dae vroeër op haar foon gestoor het) waarna hulp opgedaag het. Die aanvallers is alles net so gelos en dadelik weggehardloop toe hulle opmerk dat 'n voertuig op die toneel opdaag. Die drie mans het vermoedelik in 'n Nissan 14-bakkie op die vlug geslaan.

Sy het in 'n roerende boodskap die gesin se dankbaarheid teen die polisie, die gemeenskap en Agri NW en hul hemelse Vader betuig vir die hulp en ondersteuning wat hulle ontvang het - sy is daarvan oortuig dat die "hand van die Here" was wat die gesin bewaar het. Met ons ter perse gaan is niemand nog in verband met die voorval in hegtenis geneem nie en die ondersoek duur voort.
