There are a number of invasive weeds within the UK.

These range from the well documented Japanese Knotweed to the lesser known Ragwort.



Japanese Knotweed Its is listed by the World Conservation Union as one of "the worlds worse invasive species".

Japanese Knotweed (Fallopia Japonica) is a member of the dock family and is a Rhizomatous perennial plant with distinctive, branching and hollow like stems.

It was introduced as an ornamental plant during the 19th century for its attractive looks. The plant can grow up to a meter a month and can be extremely destructive to everything it comes into contact with, especially building foundations.





POTENTIAL MORTGAGE REFUSAL

GIANT HOGWEED

Giant Hogweed (Heracleum Mantegazzianum) is harmful not only to the environment but can cause severe blistering when it comes into contact with human skin and can leave the victim with permanent scarring. Giant Hogweed is a highly invasive plant species that will cover large areas of land if left untreated. Each individual flower head can produce up to 1500 seeds, causing soil erosion especially on riverbanks and as a result can be found in large quantities at roadside and riverbanks.



GAINT HOGWEED

IWM's 3 year control and management system can treat and eradicate Giant Hogweed.

Our fully qualified technicians will conduct a site survey and develop a bespoke treatment programme to ensure customer satisfaction.

HIMALAYAN BALSAM

Himalayan Balsam (Impatiens Glandulifera) is a relative of the Busy Lizzie, but reaches well over head height, and is a major weed problem, especially on riverbanks and waste land, but can also invade gardens. It grows rapidly and spreads quickly, smothering other vegetation as it goes. After Himalayan Balsam flowers the seed pods burst when ripe and can shoot over 20 feet, spreading the problem further.

RAGWORT

Ragwort (Senecio Jacobaea) is not usually a significant problem in gardens. However, its poisonous qualities can make it a serious weed affecting paddocks and gardens backing onto fields grazed by horses or cattle. Therefore, is it extremely important that anyone discovering this weed ensures the full and complete eradication of it. This weed is potentially dangerous that it is controlled under the Ragwort Control Act 2003. The best way to treat Ragwort is through a IWM chemical treatment programme.



RAGWORT

TREATMENT PROGRAMMES

STEM INJECTIONS



Using the stem injection technology our team applies a fast acting herbicide that kills the plant at the core. This method of eradication is extremely beneficial to customers who do not want to harm surrounding vegetation.

INSTANT REMOVAL



The instant removal method involves excavating the affected land to ensure that all Knotweed, including Rhizomes, are removed. This will then be transported to an Environment Agency approved waste site to be disposed of. This offers the customer a complete solution to their issues and is a quick, safe option for tight deadlines.

MEMBRANE



Using textile membranes, IWM create a man made barrier between a building or structure from a Knotweed infestation. This method of treatment is effective in potential border disputes or for future planning issues.
