The Agency Metric tracks their language, moving from "things happen to me" (e.g., "The system is designed for me to fail") to "I am creating my future" (e.g., "My past prepared me for this").
- **The Evidence You Receive:** We provide a timeline that clearly visualizes their progression. This qualitative data is powerful evidence for a Pre-Sentence Report (PSR) or an arbitration hearing, as it demonstrates a fundamental change in character and a reduced risk of re-offence.
