## **Day 3: Amboseli National Park.**

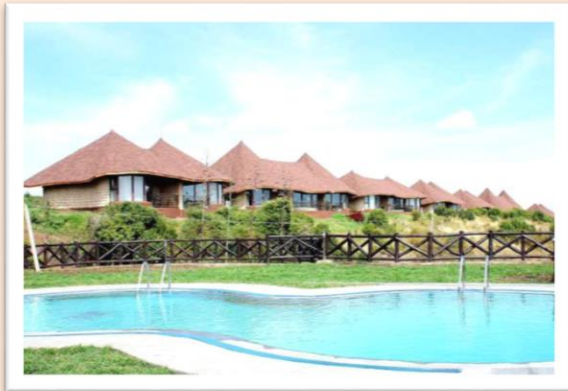

**Day 4: Amboseli - Lake Nakuru National Park.**

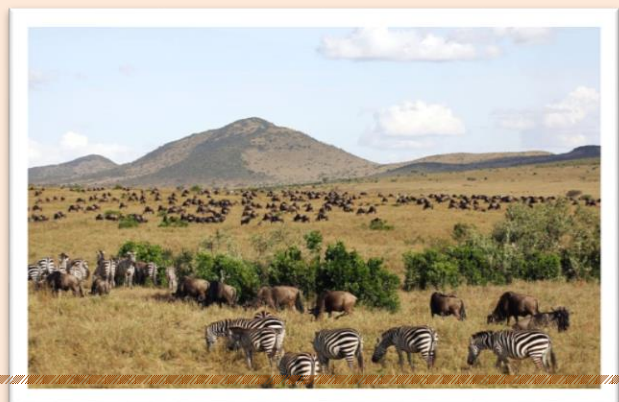
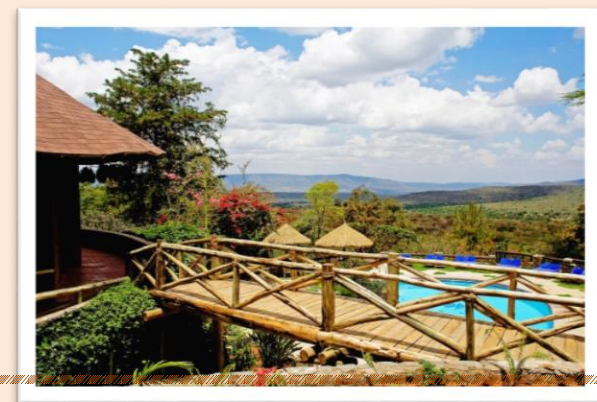

The park also serves as a sanctuary for Rothschild giraffes and both white and black rhinoceros, among many other animal species. This is also an excellent place to see gazelle, leopards, impalas and hippos. You will encounter many of them as you explore the Malaika Waterfall, beautiful Lake Nakuru and the surrounding forests. In the evening, you will enjoy splendid views from the lodge, designed to blend in with the terrain. The rustic African decor perfectly blends comfort with adventure, and the restaurant offers the finest in local and international cuisines in a relaxed setting.

**Day 5: Nakuru - Maasai Mara National Reserve.**

After all these adventures, you will be more than ready for a mid-day nap or laze on the veranda to escape the heat of the day.
