

Thomas Cook travels to next level of supplier management with Wax Digital









Thomas Cook is one of the world's leading leisure travel groups. Looking to improve management of its supplier relationships across Europe, Thomas Cook turned to web3 eSourcing, part of the web3 Source to Contract solution, to streamline its tender processes, improve collaboration and help generate cost reductions in core spend categories.

Thomas Cook was keen to embrace technology to aid procurement best practice. As part of a group wide scheme to find ways of working across the business more effectively, the procurement team was also keen to maintain a single view of procurement activity across Belgium, France, Holland, and the UK.

Proof of concept

After searching for an intuitive, easy to use system which could support multiple currencies and languages Thomas Cook trialled **Wax Digital web3** eSourcing to run an eTender event as a proof of concept.
