Category B+E (car / 4x4 / van + trailer)

Courses are run from our training centres located in Colden Common, Winchester & Greenham, Berkshire.

Age: 17 +

Theory Test: Not required.

Medical: Not required.

Course criteria: Hold a full category B driving licence and BE provisional entitlement.

Description: For those that passed their car (Cat B) driving test on or after 1st Jan 1997 and wish to tow large trailers. (I.e. Horsebox trailers & Plant trailers).

Category B+E will allow a vehicle with a MAM of 3500kg to be combined with a trailer over 750kg and up to a MAM of 3500kg.

1. Medical - Take the LGV or PCV medical – D4 form available from DVSA or Trailer Training UK Ltd.

- 2. Licence application Apply for your provisional LGV or PCV licence entitlement D2 from DVLA available from DVSA or Trailer Training UK Ltd.

- 4. Theory test Book and pass the LGV or PCV theory tests. Call DVSA on 0300 200 1122 (press option 1) or book online at gov.uk/book-a-theory-test

- 6. Driver CPC Take your initial driver CPC qualification (Module 2 & Module 4).
- 7. Driver Periodic CPC Keep up to date with your Periodic Driver CPC every year.

Driver CPC – Initial (both new LGV & PCV Drivers)

To gain the initial driver CPC qualification for new drivers of PCV & LGV you must pass the following 4 modules.

- LGV / PCV theory and hazard perception test (Module 1)
- Case study Test (Module 2)
- Practical driving test (Module 3)
- Practical demonstration test (Module 4)

Module 1 - Multiple Choice - £35 and Hazard Perception. - £15

Module 1 consists of two separate tests. The first is 100 multiple choice questions (of which the pass mark is 85) and the second 19 hazard perception clips with 20 score-able hazards (of which the pass mark is 67 out of 100).

The two tests take a total of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours to complete, but can be taken separately and in either order.

Module 2 - Case Studies - £30

In addition to passing module 1, to obtain your Driver CPC you will also need to pass module 2. This module is a computer based test and uses case studies, each one based on real-life scenarios you may encounter in your working life. It aims to test your knowledge and how you put it into practice. Written by experts from the industry, questions are based around the case study and you will be asked to answer in a number of different ways such as multiple choice answers or clicking an area on a photograph / image. Each test is made up of seven case studies, each one with six to eight questions,

With a possible maximum score of 50. The pass mark for the PCV test is 40 and the pass mark for the LGV test is 38. The test will take 1½ hours to complete and can be taken at the same test centre as module 1. Drivers, who already hold a Driver CPC for one category of vehicle (i.e. PCV or LGV) and wish to obtain a Driver CPC for the other category, will need to take a Module 2 conversion test consisting of 10 case studies with a total of 50 questions. Modules 1, 3 and 4 will need to be completed in full.



Module 3 - Practical Driving Test

The practical test is made up of two parts. The first is a reversing exercise and 5 safety questions, and is carried out at the test centre. The second takes place on public roads and may include driving on motorways. You will carry out exercises specific to the type of vehicle you drive. The practical test also includes an eco-safe driving assessment which involves the examiner taking note of how you control the vehicle and plan your driving. This assessment does not count towards the result of the test, however the examiner will give you feedback at the end of your test. The test takes $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours, with at least an hour of driving.

Module 4 - Driver CPC Practical Test - £175 + VAT + Test fee £55

In addition to passing module 3, to obtain your Driver CPC you will also need to pass module 4 a practical test focussing on vehicle safety which was developed with the support and advice of the industry. In this $\frac{1}{2}$ hour test you will be required to demonstrate your knowledge and ability in the areas listed below:

- Ability to load the vehicle with due regard for safety rules and proper vehicle use
- Security of the vehicle and contents
- Ability to prevent criminality and trafficking in illegal immigrants
- Ability to assess emergency situations
- Ability to prevent physical risk
- Demonstrate your ability through a physical, walk round vehicle safety check

The test consists of 5 topic areas which cover the Driver CPC syllabus and in order to pass the candidate has to score 15 out of a possible 20 points in each topic area (75%) and an overall score of 80%.

Can I take the modules in any order?

You must pass module 1 before you take module 3 and you must pass module 2 before you take module 4.

How will I prove I hold Driver CPC?

After you have passed all 4 modules you will be sent a Driver Qualification Card (DQC). You must carry your DQC whilst driving and there will be penalties if you are found to be driving professionally without one

Once I have passed my initial qualification, is that it?

No. A Driver CPC lasts for five years. To retain your Driver CPC you will need to complete 35 hours of periodic training every five years to continue to drive professionally.
